2014 TECHNOLOGY EXPLORATION FORUM**

The TEF 2014 CFP will remain open for submissions until July 26, 2014. - Brief description of the organization the presenter is affiliated with

WHEN: The TEF 2014 CFP is open from June 24 – July 26, 2014. All proposals will be reviewed and acceptance letters will be provided to individual speakers no later than August 14, 2014. Additionally, panels based on complementary proposals may be organized.
