



## EA PoE CERTIFIED GETTING STARTED

Here's what you should do if you're interested in submitting your products for EA PoE Certification:

1. Contact us at [poe\\_certification@ethernetalliance.org](mailto:poe_certification@ethernetalliance.org) to indicate your interest in the program.
2. Download the Certification Mark License Agreement (CMLA) for members or non-members then work with your legal department to approve, sign, and return the CMLA to the Ethernet Alliance (this is often the critical path in the process). Note membership is required for 1<sup>st</sup> party audit testing.
3. The CMLA, Product Certification, and Membership fees can be found at <https://ethernetalliance.org/poecert/membership-fees>
4. Complete Ethernet Alliance invoice payment for Gen1, Gen2, or Gen1+Gen2 CMLA for members or CMLA for non-members
5. Submit a new or derivative Gen2 product application in March 2020 or Gen1 product application now <https://ea-poe-cert.iol.unh.edu/submit-application>
6. Schedule testing of your products at UNH-IOL with a full membership, 1<sup>st</sup> party audit membership, or pay per test option <https://www.iol.unh.edu/testing/ethernet/poe>
7. Complete Ethernet Alliance invoice payment for the PoE Certified product(s)
8. Approved products will be added to the EA PoE Certified product registry <https://ea-poe-cert.iol.unh.edu>

As an Ethernet Alliance member, you have the option to certify your products yourself by following the test plan and using approved first party test equipment, which can be requested at <https://ethernetalliance.org/poecert/test-plan>

1. Complete 1<sup>st</sup> Party Audit Membership from <https://www.iol.unh.edu/testing/ethernet/poe>
2. Obtain 1<sup>st</sup> party test results using an approved test equipment from <https://ea-poe-cert.iol.unh.edu/approved-test-equipment>
3. Submit a Gen1 new or derivative product application now including 1<sup>st</sup> party test results (Gen2 PoE Certified 1<sup>st</sup> party testing is planned as a future test option) <https://ea-poe-cert.iol.unh.edu/submit-application>
4. Complete Ethernet Alliance invoice payment for PoE Certified product(s)
5. Approved products will be added to the EA PoE Certified product registry <https://ea-poe-cert.iol.unh.edu>
